Students place Gotchas' in the Gotcha box in the parade area. The data will be collated and recorded on a weekly basis. This information is to be displayed in the classroom for the students' reference. This information is also displayed on a board within the school. Students aim to navigate around the four islands throughout the year to achieve the 25,50 75 and 125 Gotcha awards. To participate in the term Celebration, the term target of 25 resets at the beginning of each term. This framework focuses on building positive relationships and strives to improve emotional, social, behavioural and academic outcomes for all students.

Students receive Gotchas throughout the 4 terms and Navigate their way around "Our Channel of Lifelong Learning", Dunk Island, Family Islands, Goold Island and Hinchinbrook Island. They are recognised for reaching each target by the awards below

25 Gotchas: DUNK ISLAND

Postcard sent home

Staff will be notified which students have achieved this and Postcards are to be inscribed with a positive message to parents praising the student and presented on parade by the Principal to the student.



50 Gotchas: FAMILY ISLANDS

Positive phone call home.

Phone call made home congratulating and informing parents/ care-givers of students PBL achievements. Phone call recorded as contact in oneschool.

75 Gotchas: GOOLD ISLAND

Nobile Navigators- Certificate and a selfie photo is sent home and a photo is added to the Navigation Wall.



125 Gotchas: HINCHINBROOK ISLAND

PBL Hat Pin

Students will receive a hat pin to wear. The hat pin is to be presented on parade by the Principal.
